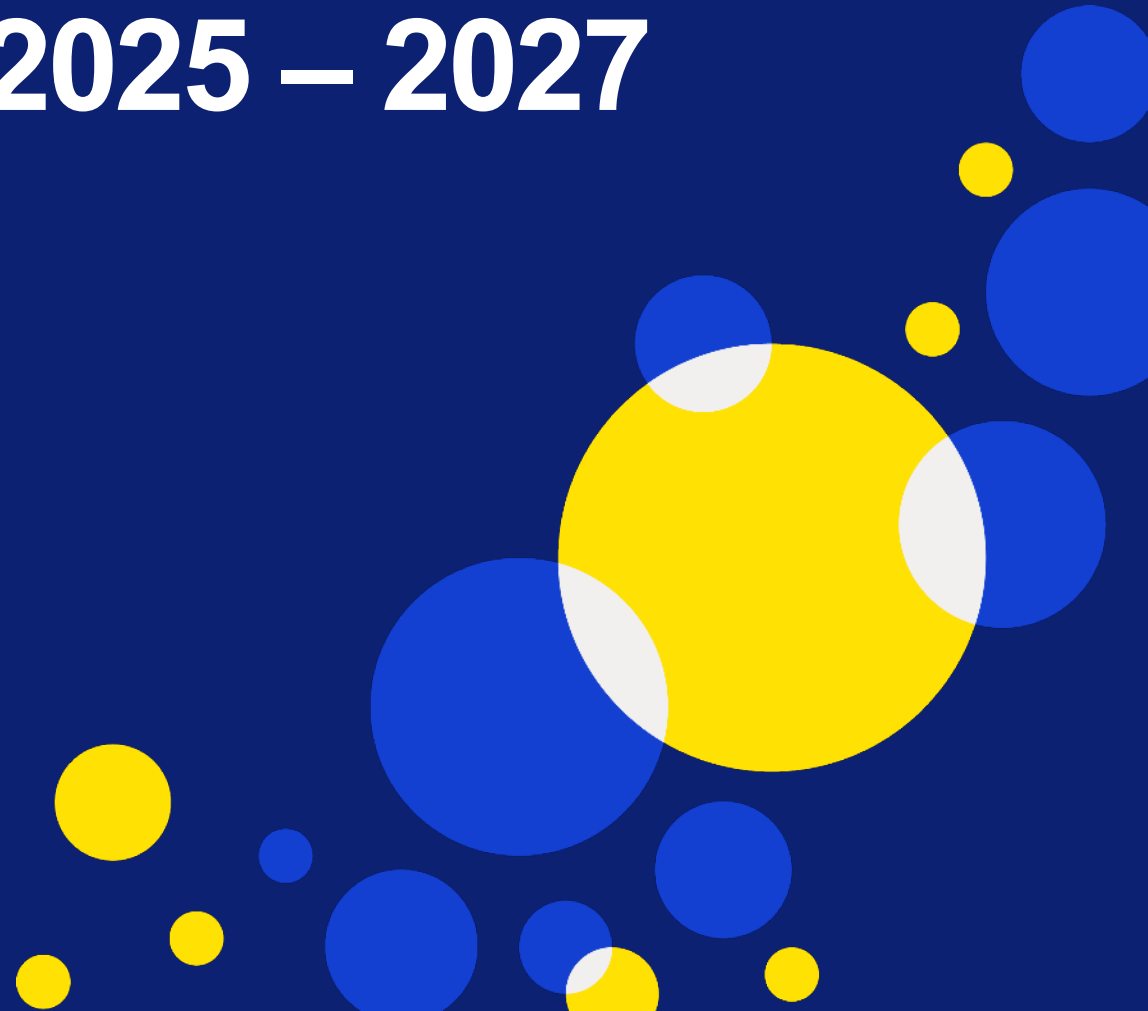





Internal market for knowledge

-  • Enabling open science via sharing and re-use of data/EOSC
-  • Strengthening research infrastructures
-  • Strengthening inclusive and intersectional gender equality
-  • Making research careers more attractive and sustainable
-  • Reforming research assessment (CoARA)
-  • Upscaling knowledge valorisation capacities and activities
-  • Global Approach to R&I (science diplomacy)

ERA actions

-  • Equity in open science and increased access to open science resources
-  • Advancing the European Science for Policy (S4P) ecosystem
-  • Facilitating and accelerating the responsible use of AI in science in the EU
-  • Enhancing research security to protect academic freedom and EU knowledge economics
