När deltagande begränsas av EU

- Reglerat i grunden i artiklarna 22(5) och 22(6) [i HE regulation](#)
- 22(5) - uteslutning av organisationer som kontrolleras från utanför EU; skydd av EU:s strategiska intressen och autonomi och säkerhet mot inflytande av tredje land
- 22(6) - eligibility criteria utöver de som är reglerade generellt, bl.a. gällande antal, typ och hemvist av de deltagande organisationer

ALLA kan exkluderas vid behov (ur Art 22(5)):

For duly justified and exceptional reasons, [...] exclude the participation of legal entities established in the Union or in associated countries directly or indirectly controlled by non-associated third countries or by legal entities of non-associated third countries from individual calls for proposals, or make their participation subject to conditions set out in the work programme.

<i>Expected EU contribution per project</i>	The Commission estimates that an EU contribution of between EUR 5.00 and 7.00 million would allow these outcomes to be addressed appropriately. Nonetheless, this does not preclude submission and selection of a proposal requesting different amounts.
<i>Indicative budget</i>	The total indicative budget for the topic is EUR 18.50 million.
<i>Type of Action</i>	Research and Innovation Actions
<i>Admissibility conditions</i>	The conditions are described in General Annex A. The following exceptions apply: In order to include a business case and exploitation strategy, as outlined in the introduction to this Destination, the page limit in part B of the General Annexes is exceptionally extended by 3 pages.
<i>Eligibility conditions</i>	The conditions are described in General Annex B. The following exceptions apply: To increase EU resilience in raw materials supply chains and thus reduce the serious risk to the Union's strategic assets, economic and societal interests, autonomy and security associated with the current EU reliance on a few third countries for critical raw materials, by increasing sustainable and responsible sourcing of primary and secondary raw

När deltagande begränsas av EU

Stor bredd av formuleringar, t.ex.

- “participation in this topic is limited to legal entities established in Member States”
- “participation is limited to legal entities established in Member States, Iceland and Norway, associated countries and OECD countries.”
- “participation in this topic is limited to legal entities established in Member States, associated countries, OECD countries, African Union Member States, MERCOSUR, CARIFORUM, Andean Community and countries with which the EU has concluded strategic partnerships on raw materials⁶⁰ as well as trade agreements (or association/economic partnership or equivalent agreements, including the new Clean Trade and Investment Partnerships) containing raw materials cooperation provisions (i.e. Energy and Raw materials chapters)⁶¹.”
- “participation is limited to legal entities established in Member States, Iceland and Norway and the following additional associated countries: Canada, Israel, Republic of Korea, New Zealand, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom. In addition, entities established in third countries which may become associated to Horizon Europe during 2026 and 2027 may be eligible to participate in this topic if the third country is identified for this topic as an eligible country in the List of Participating Countries in Horizon Europe at the time of submission of the application¹²⁵. In any case, the association agreement to the Programme must apply by the time of the signature of the grant agreement.”
- “may not participate in the action unless it can be demonstrated, by means of guarantees positively assessed by their eligible country of establishment, that their participation to the action would not negatively impact the Union’s strategic assets, interests, autonomy, or security. Entities assessed as high-risk suppliers of mobile network communication equipment within the meaning of ‘restrictions for the protection of European communication networks’ (or entities fully or partially owned or controlled by a high-risk supplier) cannot submit guarantees.¹⁵⁴”

Use of generative AI tools for proposal preparation

- Applicants:
 - **may use generative AI tools** when preparing proposals
 - **must be fully transparent** towards the granting authority and disclose which AI tools were used and how they were utilized;
 - must **exercise caution** and careful consideration while using generative AI tools;
 - must **review and validate** thoroughly any AI-generated content to ensure its appropriateness and accuracy, as well as its compliance with intellectual property regulations;
 - remain **fully responsible for the content of the proposal** (including the parts produced by AI tools);
- The use of generative AI tools in drafting proposals **may not be considered** by expert evaluators **as a reason to penalise a proposal**.



Use of generative AI for evaluation of proposals

Use of generative AI tools for proposal evaluation

Expert evaluators:

- **must not delegate** the evaluation of proposals to AI tools
- **may use AI tools**:
 - only for side tasks (e.g. to collect background information) and **not for the assessment** of proposals
 - only if the **confidentiality** of all the proposal information and the protection of **personal data** are ensured
 - only if they take necessary precautions for potential limitations of AI tools (i.e. hallucinations and biases)
- **must appropriately document** the use of AI tools (and make the documentation available to the contracting authority on request)
- **are responsible** for keeping the **confidentiality** of proposal information and the protection of **personal data**
- **must be aware that breaching confidentiality or personal data** obligations may have serious consequences, such as rejection/reduction of the remuneration/costs, suspension or termination of the contract.



Confidentiality

You must:

- **Not discuss evaluation matters** (e.g. content of proposals, evaluation results or opinions of fellow experts) with anyone, including:
 - Other experts or EU staff or any other person (e.g. colleagues, students...) not directly involved in the evaluation of the proposal.
 - **The sole exception**: Your fellow experts who are evaluating the same proposal in a consensus group or Panel review.
- **Not contact partners** in the consortium, sub-contractors or any third parties.
- **Not disclose names** of your fellow experts.
- **Maintain confidentiality of documents, paper or electronic**, at all times and wherever you do your evaluation work (on-site or remotely).
 - Do not take anything away from the evaluation building (be it paper or electronic).
 - Return, destroy or delete all confidential documents, paper or electronic, upon completing your work, as instructed.
 - Please be aware that **the use of generative AI tools** for evaluation, particularly generative AI online tools, may represent a breach of the confidentiality requirements of your contract*.



(* All proposal information must be treated as confidential, and the processing of this information in an AI tool, particularly online, that do not respect confidentiality rules must be avoided.
